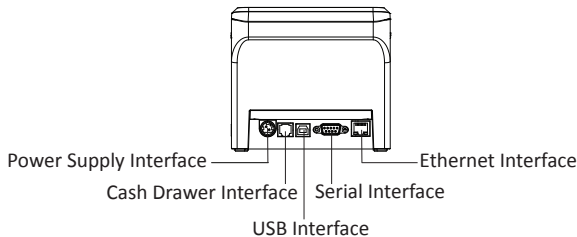
- 1. The packing materials are actually depend on the order.

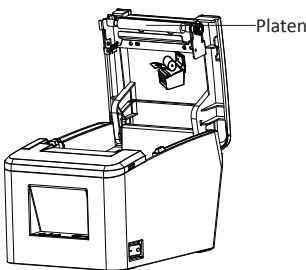

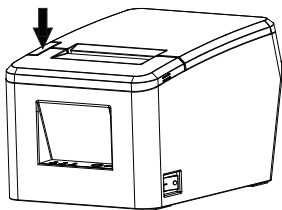


■ Opening Top Cover

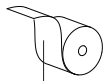
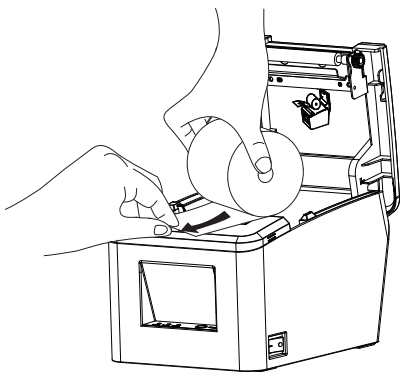


Paper Loading

- 2. Remove the used roll paper core, if any.

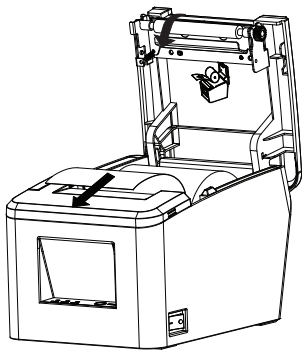


- 3. Install the roll paper in the correct direction of the roll paper.

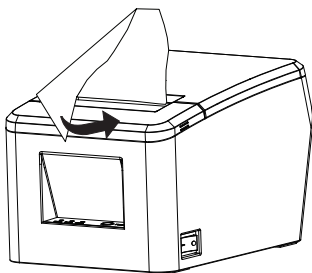


Thermosensitive Layer

3. Pull out some roll paper, and close the top cover.

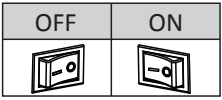


4. Tear the extra paper of the printer.

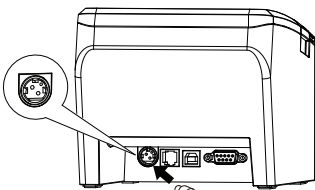


Power Supply

1. Make sure the printer power is turn off.

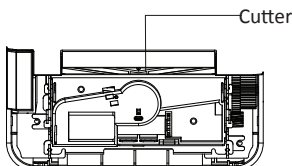
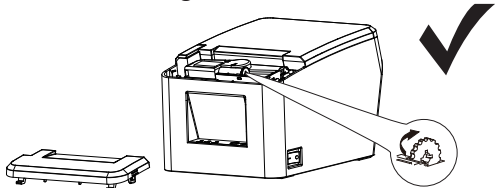


Remove Jammed Paper

1. When a paper jammed, do not press the cover open button to avoid damaging the blade.
2. Fix the printer by one hand and press either side of the convex bars by the other hand. Push up and open the front cover.

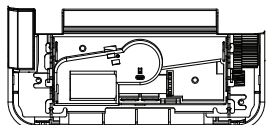


3. Please rotate the gear until the blade returns to its normal position, as shown in Figure 2.



When cutter jammed, the cutter does not retreat back and can be seen.
